50 With reference to today's Pal Post transmitted by Palcor Gather H.M.G. ready to agree Arab kings should appeal for unconditional cessation of strike and disturbances on the understanding that H.M.G. gives them the right to continuous intervention behalf Palestine Arabs stop according un-confirmed reports from arab sources only Emir Abdullah and Ibn Saud now likely sign appeal as King Ghazi insists promise stoppage of immigration stop meeting Micom with Arab supreme committee 13th September convened for the purpose of giving latter final warning actually served starting point new round political negotiations meanwhile delay gives effect to policy announced 7th September creates wide spread impression H.M.Gov. does not mean business stop feeling among Arabs now again helpful stop suggest Weizmann immediately sees Sec. of State transmit him these general impressions Palestine? ask whether H.M.
