In discussion they wld take stand on merits each issue but general trend shld be reestablish authority arms agreements condemn outrage possibly examine whether chairmans findings or absence thereof justified issue stern warning against provocation and incitement censure Jordan for failure control border and refusal attend art 12 and force it generally extend plane contact in implementing arms to maximum not reduce it lowest minimum.
