**PARTITION COMMISSION AND  
THE JEWISH CASE**

**Zionist General Council Debate**

Questions arising from the presentation of the Jewish case in all its aspects before the Partition Commission by representatives of the World Zionist Organization were discussed at a meeting on Monday of the Zionist General Council Commission.
