JEWISH DELEGATES MEET IN TEL AVIV

ALL-DAY CONFERENCE

TEL AVIV, Tuesday.— A conference of the National Council for Palestine Jews (Vaad Leumi) on current problems was held in the Herzlia Gymnasium here today and was attended by members of the Executive of the Jewish Agency, Chairmen of the various Jewish Community Councils, Municipal Councils, and Local Councils.

The Chairman, Mr. I. Ben Zvi, opened the meeting with a tribute to the 99 Jewish victims of the disturbances who fell since the last Conference two months ago.

He read the names, pausing at some to recall their particular contribution. Those attending remained standing throughout the tragic "roll-call."

Mr. Ben Zvi then referred to steps taken by the Executive of the Vaad Leumi, in its communications with Government in regard to security.

He also criticised Government's alleged infringement of the rights of the Jerusalem Jews by appointing a non-Jew as Mayor, despite the fact that the majority of the city's population is Jewish. 7 SEP 1938

Mr. M. Shertok of the Jewish Agency, delivered an address on the general situation in the country, with special reference to the security problems and their effect on the Jewish population.

A report on the activities of the Redemption Fund for the first month of its existence was rendered by Messrs. Israel Rokach, Remez and Zisling of the Executive of the Fund.

A debate on the political situation, the position of security, the activities of the Redemption Fund and unity in the Jewish community, took place in the afternoon.

Representatives of settlements in the South depicted the insecurity there and urged the extension of Jewish defence.
