GREETINGS from the Palestinian soldiers in a neighbouring country were conveyed by Mr. M. Sherok at a press conference this week. He had found them well and hearty and content with their conditions. Of more importance, perhaps, he found that they were also giving complete satisfaction to their superior officers. Relations with the British soldiers are cordial, for no distinction of race is drawn in the Army. The civilian population is taking care of their additional comforts. This is cheerful news for the prospective members of the new local units now being formed, who are coming forward with eagerness. The Jewish Agency has formed committees in Palestine to provide for the personal requirements of those who join up, and is also taking a helpful interest in their families.
