**Possibilities of Rescue**

Mr. M. Shertok, Head of the Jewish Agency's Political Department, stated that possibilities for rescue existed, contacts had been established with 12 countries, and unflagging efforts continued to be made. There were "islands of comparative security" amidst the great areas of hecatombs in Europe. Hundreds of individuals had already been saved and if funds were available, thousands more could be extricated.

The problem of immediate relief was acute whilst in some places it was essential and possible to assist in securing the deferment of decrees spelling extermination.

"We who live in Palestine have been spared and this miracle obliges us to offer an adequate thank-offering," he said. "Those who have been and can be saved will streng-

then us and assist our effort in this country.

"The yearning for Palestine today even springs from the vast graveyards and underground pioneering movement in Europe, where concentration camps are becoming pioneer centres. Palestine was built up by the Diaspora and is bound to make a return to the Diaspora, for their sake and ours."

**Truth Will Prevail**

Remarking that at the present moment an unfair attack was being levelled at Palestine Jewry, Mr. Shertok stated that they did not owe their existence to their detractors, and would pursue their path conscious that truth must prevail and that it could be demonstrated through unity and action, including the present supreme effort required to help save their kith and kin in the Diaspora.
