A resolution stating that the Inner Zionist General Council had "taken note of the Executive's statement on its line of policy based on General Council decisions concerning Zionist policy at this time" was adopted at the end of three sessions held throughout Tuesday to discuss current problems and the position caused by the resignation of Mr. D. Ben-Gurion.

Mr. M. Shertok, head of the Political Department of the Jewish Agency, in reporting on his recent visit to Egypt and talks with the civilian and military authorities, discussed the status and future of Pales in the relief and help of Jewish Communities in countries about to be liberated.
