FROM DCCIMENTARY EVIDENCE RECEIVED BY US IT APPEARS THAT ARRANGEMENTS
WERE MADE BY BRITISH AUTHORITIES TO SHIP A CONSIDERABLE QUANTITY OF
MILITARY EQUIPMENT TO THE ARAB LEGION, TIMED SO AS TO REACH TRANSJORDAL:
ON MAY 14TH AND MAY 15TH COINCIDENT WITH TERMINATION OF THE MANDATE.
TRANSPORTED ON THREE VESSELS FROM SUEZ TO AKABA, THE SHIPMENT COMPRISES
PETROL, 48 OERLIKON GUNS AND AMMUNITION, AND 255 TONS OF OTHER APMUNITION,
AND WAS CARRIED OUT WITH FULL KNOWLEDGE BY BRITISH INTELLIGENCE OF THE
ACTIVITIES AND INTENTIONS OF THE ARAB LEGION.
